  - a) Please advise if it is possible for a third party to be assigned to contact the students for participation (at least to receive the email replies from the students who can then be assigned a code number that corresponds to their student number from the classes).

Response: Yes, all the potential participants are past students of the instructor. A third party (contact information here) has agreed to contact the students via a blind carbon copy email to the class for participation in the study, and to receive any email replies from the students. Please see the revised Appendix B (Messages to the students about the study). The third party will also assign a code number to all students who wish to participate in the study, and the code number will correspond to their student number from the classes.

- 2. On the Online Consent form, the following should be included/ revised:
  - a. Indicate that confidentiality will be provided to the fullest extent possible by law.
  - b. Clearly indicate that the participant's name will not appear in any report or publications of the research.
  - c. Specify how the data will be securely stored, for how long and what will happen to the data after the retention period.
  - d. Indicate: "This research has received ethics review and approval by the Human Participants Review Sub-Committee, York University's Ethics Review Board and conforms to the standards of the Canadian Tri-Council Research Ethics guidelines."
